Welcome recognizes the faces it sees and sends the names of identified people to the user's smartphone. The camera notifies the user exactly who is at home, the neighbor coming to water the plants while a family is away or a burglar.

Welcome also detects acoustic alarms. The camera sends a notification and records a video whether it detects a smoke alarm, CO alarm, security alarm or siren. Welcome turns any traditional alarms into smart alarms, helping the user to better protect their home.

Netatmo Tags add an extra layer of security to the house: they alert the user when a door or a window is opened, even before an intrusion occurs.

Tags are waterproof and can be installed at all home entrance points – doors, windows, blinds, gates – indoor or outdoor. They detect when a door or a window is moving, shaken or left wide open and send notifications to the user's smartphone.
